Steps and Tips for Stain Removal

CHECKLIST

• BLOT LIQUID STAINS IMMEDIATELY.	
• WORK FROM THE BACK. PLACE STAINED SIDE	OF FABRIC DOWN.
WORK ON ABSORBENT SURFACE SUCH AS CLEAN	WHITE PAPER TOWELS.
CHANGE TOWELS OFTEN TO AVOID RESTAINING.	
• AVOID EXCESSIVE RUBBING, WHICH MAY DAM	AGE THE FIBERS OR
FINISH, REMOVE THE COLOR, OR SPREAD THE ST	AIN.
• TREAT STAINS PROMPTLY. FRESH STAINS ARE	MORE EASILY REMOVED.
• TEST STAIN-REMOVAL PRODUCT ON SEAM ALL	OWANCE OR HIDDEN PART OF GARME
IF COLOR IS AFFECTED, DO NOT USE THAT PRODU	ICT.
• ALLOW ALL DRY-CLEANING SOLVENTS TO EVAF BEFORE WASHING.	PORATE COMPLETELY
RINSE OUT STAIN REMOVER PRODUCTS BEFORE	WASHING.
ALWAYS USE THEM IN A WELL-VENTILATED ROC	m.
MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS WHEN AVAILE	BLE.
• DO NOT USE COLORED TOWELS OR CLOTHS THA	IT MAY LEAVE A DYE STAIN.
